



GUIDELINES (Revised 5-6-14)

Below are some basic guidelines for your safety and for the consideration and respect for others who will also be using the camp facilities.

1. Promptness is necessary. Arrive at 8:00 a.m. and leave at 4:00 p.m. daily. Child may be dropped off between 7:30 and 8:00 a.m.
2. Always remain in the enclosed campgrounds.
3. Ask for permission from camp staff if you wish to explore the grounds during a break. Take at least one person and your watch with you. Listen for the bell that signals it's time to return after a break.
4. Enter only the buildings that are reserved for use by our group.
5. Bring items on the **PACKING LIST**.
6. Keep money, valuables, electronic devices, and cell phones at home. Certainly, weapons, illegal contraband or controlled substances are NOT allowed.
7. Courtesy and respect for self and others is a must. This is demonstrated with acceptable language and behavior. Helpfulness is encouraged. We will become a team during camp.
8. Respect for the camp property and everything in it is required. This is demonstrated by cleaning up after oneself, and taking care not to remove anything that doesn't belong to you, or damage or destroy anything on the grounds or in the buildings.
